

# **Regional Young Members Co-ordinator** **(RYMC)**

## **Job Description**

### **Overview**

RYMCs liaise with Branch Young Members Contacts (BYMCs) and the Regional Director of their area. When time requires to also liaise with fellow RYMCs and other RDs. They also liaise with the Young Members Group Committee (YMGC) with the campaigning aims and promotion of issues affecting Young CAMRA Members (18-30 year olds), and other young people at the forefront.

### **Duties**

This list of duties is what the YMGC see the role of the RYMC to incorporate. The list is by no means exhaustive and many may find other thing to add to it:

- I. Always look out for and attempt to establish BYMCs in Branches that may have none.
- II. Encourage BYMCs to activate already Young Members (YMs) in Branches.
- III. Work with BYMCs and Branch Committees to increase the number of YMs and to activate and retain them.
- IV. When possible hold two face-to-face 'feed back' meetings [in different halves of the year] with BYMCs, to discuss what has been achieved and what more can be done [relating to the duties above]. A meeting of all BYMCs together in your Region may be more productive than individually. This can be informal and may work better as a social event [see point X].
- V. Support, help and try to solve problems BYMCs may have.
- VI. Liaise with BYMCs, your RD and the YMGC and liaise between the three.
- VII. When there is no BYMC is place, BYMCs responsibilities default to RYMCs.
- VIII. Send regular reports to your Regional Meetings and attend them. If unable to do so give your apology and try to send a written report.
- IX. Send your Regional Reports to the YMGC, as well as attend the YMGC Meetings, especially if the meeting is in your region.
- X. Organise social events for all YMs in your Region. At least two would be desirable.
- XI. Try and organise a nationwide event each year, to fit into the RYMC's rota.
- XII. Disseminate best practice and when at events always act responsible.
- XIII. Understand and use the support network in place. Do not be embarrassed by asking for help and advice. We're all here to help and succeed.
